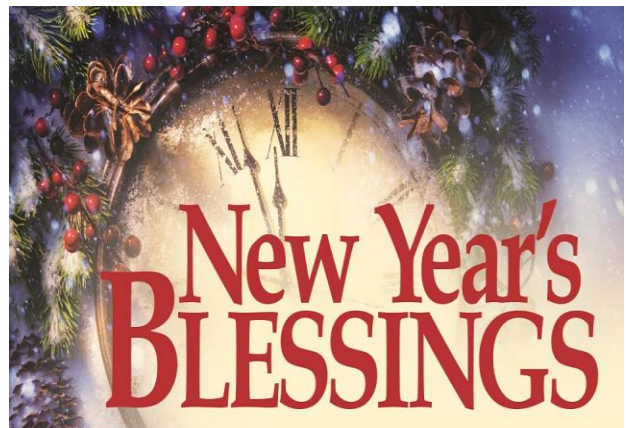

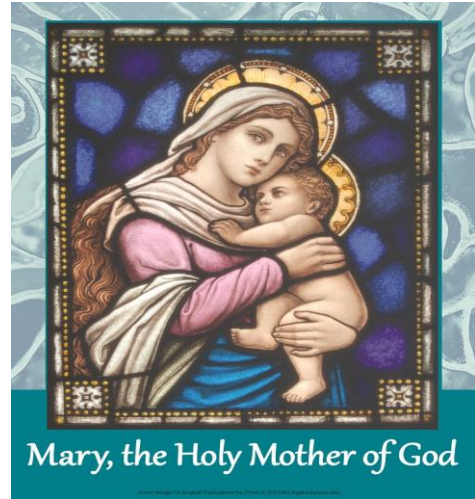

Solemnity of Mary, The Holy Mother of God
