**February 19, 2017**

**Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time**

The message today is one of love. It's not a Valentine's Day kind of love, but rather a consuming *agape* kind of love. When we allow this kind of love to fill our hearts from top to bottom, there is room for nothing else. Today, we open with a reading from the book of Leviticus – an instruction book, of sorts. In this first reading, God leads with a direct command, saying there is no room for hate in the God-loving heart. No hatred, no revenge, no grudges. Love your neighbor as yourself. As we move into the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that the body is a temple, a sacred space. It was never meant to house sin and hate. “If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person.” Finally, in the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus bridges the gap from the Old Testament to the New by explaining the kind of love that was driving the teachings of Moses. He negates the old ways of thinking with new ways of acting. His words are challenging in times of angst and division. This was true for the disciples and it is still true today. Do not allow the political disputes of our day lead you into sinful anger and hatred. Rather, always strive to share the perfect love of the Father with one another.
