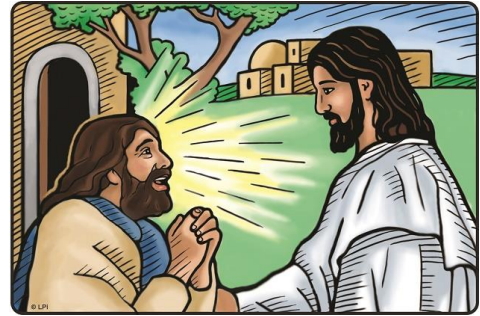

Fourth Sunday of Lent

In today’s gospel, we hear of the man whose lifelong blindness was cured by Jesus. There is a great deal of theology behind these words “and now I see.” Jesus frequently heals the deaf and the blind, helping those people to hear and to see. But he also criticizes the Pharisees for having ears and not hearing, and for having eyes and not seeing.
