Pastor's Corner

A couple weeks ago I made mention of Pope Leo's new document Magnifica Humanitas. During my trip I was able to read it through and wanted to share some thoughts here in my column. First, I should note that it is a rather long document at around 42,000 words or 83 pages in a PDF. Because of its length, the text goes into all sorts of topics that are secondary to the main point.

The main point seems to be this: safeguarding the dignity of the human person in an age of technological changes. The Catholic Church has always proclaimed the importance of God's design for the human race in general and each person in particular. This is especially so following the Incarnation of Jesus Christ - which is to say, when God became man in Jesus. The Church thinks it important to continually uphold human dignity in every age since there are constant threats that undermine it or cause us to forget this important truth.

Today the threat is that we equate certain technologies with human abilities. This is, perhaps, one of the most important areas that the document addresses. In paragraph 99 he writes about artificial intelligence: "We must avoid the misconception of equating this type of 'intelligence' with that of human beings. These systems merely imitate certain functions of human intelligence." In other words, the phrase "artificial intelligence" is an oxymoron since only human persons, angels, and God have true intelligence. Computers and machines only mimic intelligence. The Pope continues: artificial intelligences "may imitate language, behavior... or even simulate empathy and understanding, but they do not understand what they produce, for they lack the affective, relational, and spiritual perspective through which human beings grow in wisdom."

One practical take away from this is to beware of artificial relationships with AI agents or chatbots. This is especially important to keep in mind with children since they can easily believe that such things understand them and care. AI doesn't truly understand like another human person does nor does it care. It is fundamentally incapable of these things.
