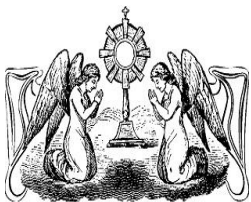

“FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES”

February 3, 2019

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today’s gospel offers us an important lesson in hospitality, the first pillar of Stewardship. In this passage, Jesus is “received” by His own people in His own town at first warmly, but then rejected with violence. The people were so familiar with Jesus, they could not accept that He and His words from God. We are left asking ourselves this question: do I receive Jesus hospitably, or am I also guilty of placing expectations on Him? Is my reception of Him self-centered and self-serving? Have I ever rejected Him when I did not get the response I was seeking? And remember – our discipleship also calls us to act with hospitality toward one another. As we reflect on our acceptance of Jesus, we can also reflect on our acceptance of one another, keeping in mind that “whatever you do for the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.” Do we see the Lord “fully alive” in them?

Since we are all individually parts of Christ's  
body the Church, we all have gifts to share for  
the good of all. Last week I mentioned a few  
practical steps to discerning the gifts God has  
apportioned us, so I thought I'd include them  
in written form to aid in this discernment.

1. First, ask the Holy Spirit to illuminate your  
mind and inspire your will. This is  
indispensable.

2. Make it a habit of reading Scripture and  
listening attentively to the Word of God  
proclaimed at Mass.

3. Reflect upon these five questions.

- The first is, "What do people compliment  
me about?"

- Other people can see something in  
me that I may not be able to see in  
myself

- The second is, "What comes easily to me?"

- The third is, "What do I like to read about?  
What would keep me up at night reading  
or studying?"

- The fourth is, "what gets me up early in the  
morning excited?"

- The fifth is, "what activities give me  
energy?"
