Palm Sunday

On this Palm Sunday, you may find it easy to feel a bit of sadness or anger or despair as you read the passion according to Luke. It is, after all, a grim story. For the Jewish people, it was even a story of disappointment, as they really hoped that this Jesus would be “the one.” Thankfully, as Christian disciples, we know that the story does not end there -- that this is a story of resurrection and hope! Take a moment to reflect on today's reading from Philippians, where Jesus is shown in great glory! “He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave....he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death....God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name....Jesus Christ is Lord.” Jesus shows us that to be FULLY ALIVE means to surrender yourself completely to God's will! It may not be pretty. It may not please others. It may not be what you had in mind. As disciples, we are called to put our selfish desires aside and place ourselves in the Potter's hands, allowing Him to mold us as He wills. As we enter into Holy Week, let us remember that we are called to holiness, which can only be achieved through surrender.

From the pastor's desk

Unlike other novenas, where people ask for something from God through the intercession of His Holy Saints, the Divine Mercy Novena is intended to be prayed for graces and/or salvation to be given to other people. Jesus asked that this nine day novena be prayed prior to the Feast of Divine Mercy (the Sunday after Easter), *beginning on Good Friday*. He gave St. Faustina Kowalska an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena. In her diary, St. Faustina wrote that Jesus told her: "On each day of the novena you will bring to My heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy ... On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My passion, for the graces for these souls."

Pamphlets with the novena can be obtained or the entire novena can be found online.
