April 28, 2019

Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday)

We are an Easter People! We live in the age of the Resurrected Christ and we are baptized into a faith that calls us into stewardship and evangelization. In today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, we see the earliest "Easter People" in action. They continued to spread the good news. They cared for one another; they cured the sick; they cast out unclean spirits. In short, they continued the work begun by Jesus. You and I are called into the same mission, but we would be wise to remember another story...the story of the boy with the evil spirit in Mk 9: 14-29. In this passage, which actually took place before the resurrection, the disciples were unable to cast out the boy's demons, and they had to call on the help of Jesus. When the disciples asked why they were unsuccessful, Jesus explained that this kind of demon can only come out by prayer. As missionary disciples, we **MUST** remember that we do not act of our own accord; we act in accordance with the will of God. We cooperate with His plans and we must include prayer and fasting as we do so. If we are to continue living as an Easter People, then we must always work in conjunction with the one who commissioned us to do so!
