Sixth Sunday of Easter

As He did last week, Jesus speaks again today of the importance of love: "Whoever loves me will keep my word..." [Let us remember that in the opening passage of John's Gospel, 'word' refers to Jesus Himself!] Jesus assures the disciples that they will see Him again, but what He means is that He will be recognizable *within* them because of their mutual love and respect. As missionary disciples, we also carry Jesus within us and that should be clear to others by our words and our deeds. A well-known church hymn says, "...we'll guard each man's dignity and save each man's pride and they'll know we are Christians by our love." Sometimes love is a kind smile or a well-timed hug. Other times it is more aggressive — standing up for the "unlovable" as Saint Theresa did, or working to find empathy for your own enemy. We are called to change the world, which is a monumental task that can only be accomplished through love. Allow the love of Jesus, which dwells within YOU, to pour forth upon those you encounter.
