The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Today we pause to reflect on the Most Holy Trinity, one of the great mysteries of our faith. Pope St. John Paul II attempted to explain this mystery by referring to the Trinity as the Divine Family. The Father loves the Son, the Son loves the Father, and the Holy Spirit IS the love that exists between the two of them. Three persons...one God...since the beginning of time. As an expression of love, the Divine Family (God) created us and gave us dominion over the Earth and all its creatures. We were literally created as stewards, which can only be seen as an act of love for God and His gifts to us. We are God’s children—offspring of the Divine Family and created in God’s own image; therefore, we must behave as such. Let us live in gratitude and give all glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Stewardship is the grateful response of a Christian disciple, who recognizes and receives God’s gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor!

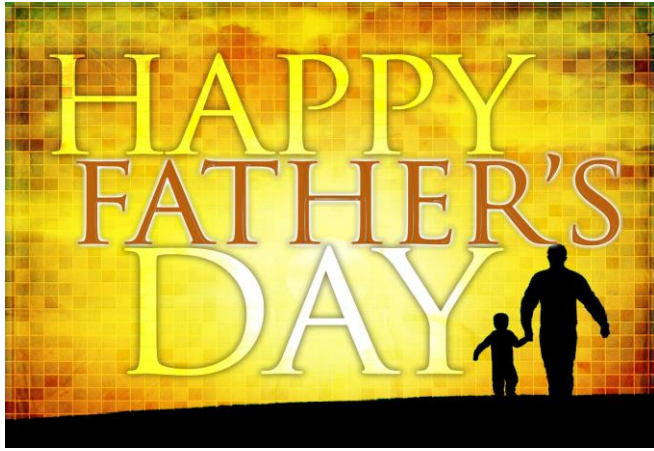
Liturgy of the Hours (Morning Prayer)
